



XODCA PRIVACY POLICY

The X One Design Class Association (XODCA) works to preserve X boats as a One Design Class, to promote their racing and to administer the affairs of the Association as provided for in the Constitution and Class Rules. The XODCA Constitution includes the term “class register” which shall mean the register of owners of XOD boats, with their addresses, name and number of boat.

Membership of the XODCA is divided into Full Members who solely or jointly own an XOD boat, Associate Members who are not boat owners and Honorary Members who have been nominated by the Class Committee and confirmed at an AGM. All owners shall be Full Members of the XODCA.

To comply with the XODCA Constitution, personal data from Members will be included in the class register. The personal data collected and stored from Members will be names, addresses, telephone numbers, email addresses, memberships of yacht clubs and XOD Division, boat names and boat numbers.

These data are for the benefit of other members of the Association and to facilitate communication between members. These data are also to facilitate communication between the XODCA and the members of XOD information, such as regattas, social events, meetings and Class developments, to meet the objectives of the XODCA.

Personal data will be stored by the XODCA in paper files and on an electronic database. Lists of Members, their contact details, their yachts and the yachts in each Division are published annually in the XODCA Handbook. The List of Members in the XODCA Handbook is a confidential list and is preceded by the statement: “In order to conform to the Data Protection Act, Members must not pass information from the Handbook to Non-members.” Additionally, every year, as an Affiliated Class, the XODCA sends a list of boat numbers, boat names, and names of owners to the Solent Cruising & Racing Association for publishing in The Solent Book, to annually update the section “Affiliated Classes”.

The XODCA Handbook is sent to all members of the XODCA. It may also be sent to XODCA approved yacht clubs and to practicing boat builders and sail-makers supplying the Class, for purposes of reference to the Class measurement Rules.

Suppliers may seek to send the XODCA information on promotions, offers and new developments of potential benefit to Members. The XODCA at its discretion will forward these communications to Members on an ongoing basis.

A Member can request for their personal data to be removed from published lists or from postal and email distribution lists. If a Member has any objection or wishes to opt out from receiving promotional messages from suppliers, they are asked to contact the Class Secretary on xodsec@tiscali.co.uk.
