

Duties of Divisional Technical Representatives

The primary role of a Divisional Technical Representative is to support the Class Committee, Divisional Captain and the Class Members at all times, as detailed in Section B – Organisation B 4.2c and d.

The Tasks of a TAC Member are:-

1. To support the Class Secretary and their Divisional Captain to ensure that the Class Records concerning all the boats in their Division are up-to-date and that this information is correctly displayed on the Class central records.
2. To accept full responsibility for organising and running any trials within their Division requested by the Class Committee, including recording and completing any reports necessary and ensuring that the report is returned to the Chairman of TAC by the date requested.
3. To support his Class Members in all respects and be duty bound to accept any queries or proposals. Discuss them with the Divisional Captain and Members as necessary and where appropriate bring such proposals forward to TAC for consideration.
4. To carry out or assist, the Official Class Measurer, the Divisional Captain or his Appointed Representative in carrying out any measuring and weighing of any boat within his fleet as required.
